


Edera platform testing in North Karelia

- heavy rain 14.5.2021
- storm 20.9.2023



North Karelia Rescue Department NKRD

- Regional rescue department in eastern Finland.
- Area 21600 km², 163000 inh.
- First responder to all type disasters or accidents, typically structural fires, forest fires, traffic accidents, water operations, storms, chemical accidents, oil spills
- First response in medical tasks, medical emergency.
- 5000 rescue operations, 42000 paramedic missions
- 31 rescue stations overall in North Karelia region, 15 of them with ambulances 24/7.
- 300 professional firefighters/paramedics
- 400 part-time workers or volunteer firefighters.
- Heavy rescue team and member in FI GFFF-V module (EUCPP) for forest fires.


Two cases


- Storm 20.9.2023
 - FMI early warning
 - Nearly 70 rescue tasks around the NK area
 - Damages to buildings, powerlines by fallen trees-> power cuts in wide areas
- Heavy rain 14.5.2021
 - No FMI early warning
 - Only few rescue tasks in minor area
 - Damages to buildings, roads by flooded water












Edera platform map 20.9.2023




Onnettomuusselosteet, Onnettomuusselosteen liitteet (vt-selosteet) = Ei









FMI lightning map 14.5.2021

Observations of Edera platform

- Easy to use
 - "most important component in rescue service"
 - "fireman friendly" to use
- Data loading in fast enough
- In NK most needed are the storm impacts
 - Wind damages
 - Rain damages
- Flood situations was not observed
 - are quite rare in NK
- Platform should be used in situation or command centers at rescue departments
