


AMAYA in a process of change

In April 2023 the Regional Government of Andalusia has approved the creation of the **Agencia de Seguridad y Gestión Integral de Emergencias (ASEMA)** -*Security and emergency management Agency*- with the aim of grouping different emergency entities into a common management system. The INFOCA and other personnel from AMAYA's structure will be integrated into this new agency.

Mitigation activities in forest areas



The operations carried out were marking and signaling problems, felling, cutting and delimiting of fallen trees and removing mud and debris accumulated on roads and routes.

Mitigation activities in urban areas

The operations carried out were:

- drain stagnant water from flooded areas.*
- cleaning of streets and buildings using water from firefighting vehicles.*
- removal manually and with machinery of mud and debris accumulated.*
- Transportation of furniture and particular items to storage areas.*

OBJECTIVES:

1. Improve 'internal' procedures in case of floods (and extreme meteorological events in general)

1.1. Distribute official warnings to INFOCA staff. Specifically to people working alone in fire lookout towers.

1.2. Preventive measures in risky areas before the event. Tools, PPE, People on duty or in advise.


1.3. Distribute official warning information to all the staff in AMAYA to prevent impacts in outdoor activities.


